He holds a Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin and taught previously at SUNY at Buffalo. He is coauthor with Jason D. Mycoff of *Conflict & Compromise: Presidential and Congressional Leadership, 2001-2006* and coauthor with John Anthony Maltese and H. Phillips Shively of *Government Matters: American Democracy in Context*. He served for seven years on the Delaware State Board of Education, four years as president. John Anthony Maltese is the Albert B. Saye professor and head of the department of political science at the University of Georgia. He holds a Ph.D. from Johns Hopkins University. He is the author of *The Selling of Supreme Court Nominees* and *Spin Control: The White House Office of Communications and the Management of Presidential News*, and coauthor with Joseph A. Pika and H. Phillips Shively of *Government Matters: American Democracy in Context*. He is a Josiah Meigs Distinguished Teaching Professor and was named the Georgia Professor of the Year by the Carnegie Foundation and the Council for Advancement and Support of Education (CASE).
