Hendrik Van den Berg is Professor of Economics at the University of Nebraska Lincoln, where he teaches economic growth and development as well as international economics. He received B.A. and M.A. degrees in economics from the State University of New York at Albany in 1971 and 1973, respectively, and M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in economics from the University of Wisconsin Madison in 1987 and 1989. Between studying in New York and Wisconsin, Hendrik served as a Foreign Service Officer at the United States Embassy in Managua, Nicaragua in the position of Commercial Officer, and at the U.S. Trade Center in São Paulo, Brazil, as Market Research and Promotion Officer. He left the United States Department of State to manage the São Paulo office of Marsteller Advertising, and later worked as Planning Manager for Singer of Brazil, also in São Paulo. Hendrik traveled widely for Singer and experienced the challenges of living and managing businesses in developing economies. In 1985, Hendrik decided to return to his first love, economics, and enrolled at the University of Wisconsin.

Hendrik has published many articles on exchange rates, international trade, alternative estimates of economic growth, the empirical relationship between international trade and economic growth, and, most recently, the determinants and consequences of immigration on source and destination countries. Currently, he is examining the biases of neoclassical economics and the influence of the neoclassical paradigm on the fields of international economics and economic development.

Hendrik also regularly writes for general audiences, including monthly articles on economic policy, peace,

and social justice in *Nebraska Report*, the newspaper of Nebraskans for Peace. He also writes for the *Nebraska Worker*, the newsletter of the Nebraska Industrial Workers of the World. He is often invited to speak on immigration, foreign trade, and international finance.
