Drescher realizes that middle childhood is parents' "last good chance to hold your child close" and make an impact before the storm of adolescence rocks the family. Drescher overlays his suggestions with a comforting spiritual tone bolstered by biblical quotes and ecumenical references to "The Creator." He could make more distinctions between children within this wide age range, since 6-year-olds are quite different from 10-year-olds.
